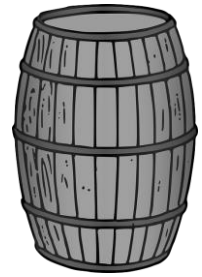




2017 Curiosities & Collectibles Flea Market
BOOTH SPACE AGREEMENT
September 24, 2017
11am to 4pm
Gate 4 – Manitoba Agricultural Museum, Austin, MB.



Limited spaces are available inside the Heritage Building (first-come basis) or outdoors (vendors can work out of the back of their vehicle if desired). The Flea Market is adjacent to the day parking lot and public campground.

The lunch canteen will be operated from 10am to 4pm with an assortment of foods available.

VENDOR PAYMENT

- Agreements received without payment will not be considered.
- Agreements received with post-dated cheques will not be considered.
- Cheques for payment of booth space which are returned NSF will be subject to a \$25 service charge. Upon notification by MAM, funds to cover the NSF fee and booth space must be received by MAM by cash or certified cheque within 2 weeks, or the application will be deemed cancelled.
- **NO REFUNDS.** If vendors are unable to attend after paying for their space, the Museum must be notified in writing before September 17, 2017 and the fee will be transferred to the next year. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

BOOTH SPACE

- Booth spaces are provided without tables, chairs or any other items. Participants must supply all items they require. Set up can begin at 8am. Take-down NOT to begin until 4pm unless prior arrangements have been made.
- Booth spaces are 12'x12' at a cost of \$15 each; and are payable before September 1, 2017. After that date, fees increase to \$25 per 12'x12' space.
- Limited electricity for indoor spaces is available at a cost of \$15. Display lights to a maximum of 300 watts may be used. Each booth using electricity is required to pay the \$15 fee. **PLEASE** – electricity to be used for lights only. If a fan is required, it must be operated by a source other than electricity.

PUBLIC ADMISSION

- Admission is \$3 per person, 12 and under FREE.

CONDITIONS

- Displays must be contained within the 12'x12' space, or purchase additional space.
- Vendors are responsible for their own Security, Insurance and Business Licenses (if applicable).
- We reserve the right to refuse any application.
- Camping is available nearby on a first-come basis nearby at the rate of \$30 per night (30 amp power and water), \$20 per night (15 amps), \$20 for tents.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED:

- Public Address systems or loud hailers.
- Food sales of any kind or any sales in competition with the Museum.
- No raffles in competition with the Museum.
- The sale of alcohol or pornography is not allowed.
- No high pressure solicitation allowed.

The Museum will not be held responsible for accidents or loss. Exhibitors will be evicted for actions offensive to the public.

The below named Flea Market vendor has read and understood the above information, and has agreed to, and will abide with; the conditions set forth and has paid the agreed fee.
