Harvest Helpers

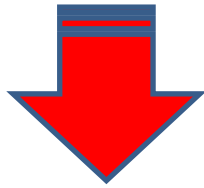
Experience the Harvest:

BBQ pit only: \$20 (must be pre-booked)

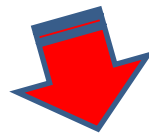
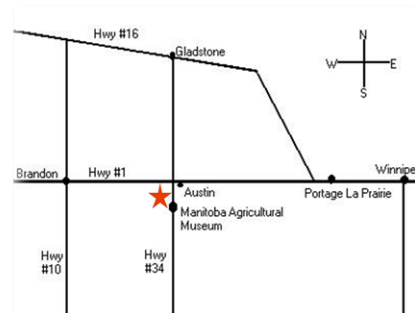
